Entrances

All entranceways of our schools are secured by a **coded entry security system**, ensuring that only our families and teachers can enter the building unassisted. In some centers, even the front doors themselves are a security feature, preventing children from exiting the building alone.

Cleanliness

Our centers are thoroughly cleaned every evening and over each weekend. We only use environmentally friendly cleaning products which are a much safer alternative to traditional cleaning products for many reasons.



Nutritious Meals and Snacks

Nutrition is essential to fuel optimal growth and development in order for children to reach their full potential. **Busy Bees has partnered with nutrition experts** to ensure that all meals and snacks on our menu meet the highest nutritional value.

Busy Bees provides a nutritious snack each morning and afternoon and a nutritious lunch each mid-day. We also will provide a rotating breakfast option for early arrivals. Our menu rotates on a five week basis and includes fresh or frozen fruits and vegetables and high-quality protein sources. We also offer a vegetarian option on days when meat is served. Our guidelines reduce the intake of sugar and salt as we believe that food choices during childhood lay the foundation for life long eating habits.

All Busy Bees centers are completely **peanut and tree nut free**, and we work with the families of children that have other food sensitivities and allergies to ensure the safety and well-being of all children in our centers.
